PACKALLIANCE TRAINING PROGRAM ON CIRCULAR ECONOMY COMPETENCE APPLIED TO THE PLASTICS PACKAGING SECTOR IS READY TO BE LAUNCHED!

The PackAlliance training program on Circular Economy competence applied to the Plastics Packaging sector will be launched opening a call for recruiting 15-20 students from each participating country (Italy, Spain, Poland and Finland) involving, at least, a total of 60 students

Student selection

PackAlliance partners have already scheduled and set the final details of the PackAlliance Postgraduate Programme from the open call for student's recruitment.



Student Enrolment: From June to September 2021

Course Date: October 2021-May 2022

Administrative preparation and first call for students will start on June 2021 to September 2021.

The aspirant students should have a professional profile as competence from their own field, achieved through a degree or working life, with the added specialization in the needs for the CE of the plastics packaging industry.

The overall professional profile for a person taking the programme will be therefore more generic, and the profile will not be necessarily connected to a certain discipline, but the needs of a professional will be recognized in all or several of the thematic areas.

MODULES



The topics of the learning modules included characteristics, recycling, approval, and legislation related to new materials and biomaterials in the plastics packaging sector. In addition, recent sustainable production and processing technologies, especially in the sector of food packaging systems, will be covered, as well as the eco-packaging market trends and ways to reduce overall costs. LCA during the product life cycle of sustainable and recycled plastics packaging, as well as the related EU legislation will be elemental parts of the studies. Courses about the logistics of sorting, as well as methods to improve sorting and recycling systems will be provided. In addition, for example, new recycling opportunities in creation of business models are included. Communications, service design and the societal impact of the CE will also be covered.
