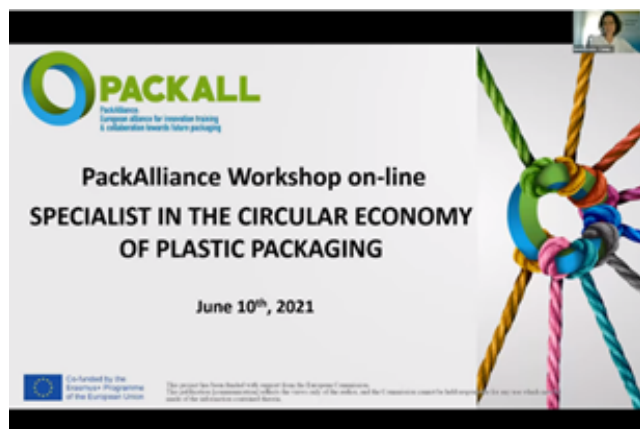

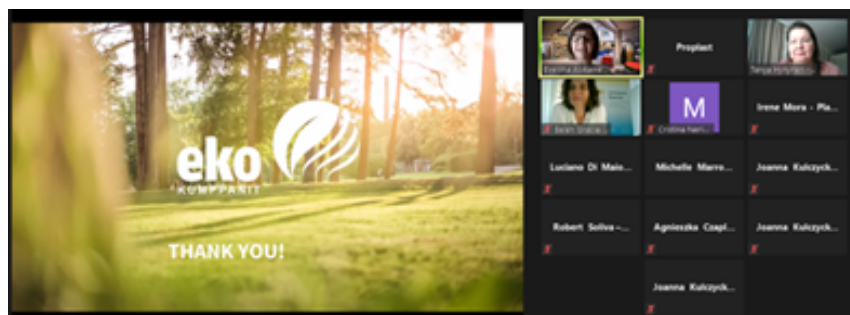

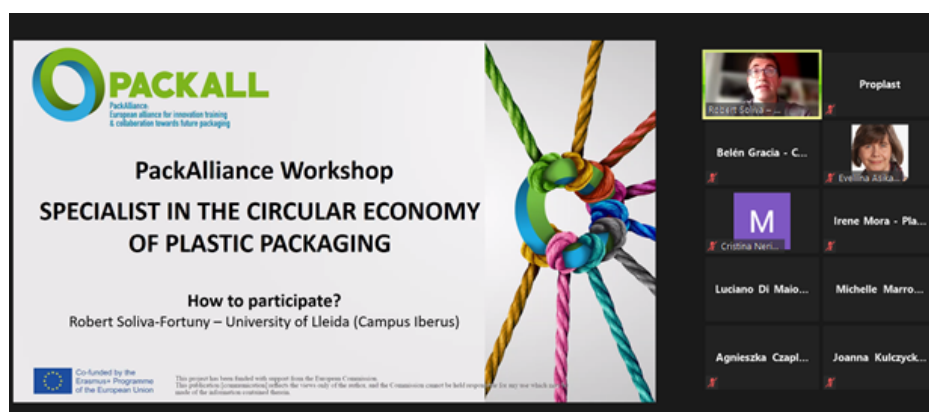
PackAlliance Workshop on-line has been organized on June 10th, 2021 to promote the course to the most important and relevant stakeholders.
