PACKALL HUBS ARE READY!!

From March 27th 2022 to May 21th 2022 students from Spain, Italy, Poland and Finland will participate to the PackAll Hubs, as a mean of centres of educational, innovation and entrepreneurial excellence in CE for the plastics packaging sector.

The students will analyze and solve different challenges proposed by sector representatives to stimulate innovative and entrepreneurial spirits, using a novel challenge-based training methodology called CHAINS (CHAllenge INnovation teams).



The practical module, based on challenges, will allow students to be in contact with industry representatives, not only to apply the specific knowledge acquired in the framework of the programme, but also to stimulate transversal skills such as innovation, cocreation and Furthermore, entrepreneurship. transnational mobility activities during the practical module of the training programme will additionally allow students to gather international experience.

CHAINs will approach the challenge through an innovation methodology based on Design Thinking that englobes three phases:

- 1- Definition phase (1 week): Fully understanding of the challenge, information gathering, ...
- 2- Ideation phase (4 weeks): includes several divergence and convergence sub-phases to choose and define the idea for the solution
- 3- Prototyping phase (4 weeks): validation and manufacturing of the ideated prototype
