

PRIVACY POLICY

The main objectives of the consortium are:

To equip Higher Education students and packing professionals with industry-demand skills required for circular economy transformation within the plastic packaging sector

To modernize and align Higher Education Institutions curricula with the plastic packaging industry needs

To establish innovative collaboration schemes between Higher Education Institutions and industry based on the knowledge, talent transfer and entrepreneurship in sustainable plastic packaging area

A. Purpose and legal basis of the processing of personal data

In accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, of 27 April (General Data Protection Regulation - GDPR), the personal data we request is that necessary to carry out

the objectives and activities of the project and will be shared within the Pack Alliance project partners.

Processing shall be carried out under the legal bases provided for in Article 6.1 of the GDPR. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time (see Your Rights hereunder).

1. When you make use of our website:

We use a third-party service, Google Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behavior patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way which does not identify anyone. We do not make any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website.

The data will be stored in a database processed by Proplast and will be automatically deleted at the end of retention time.
