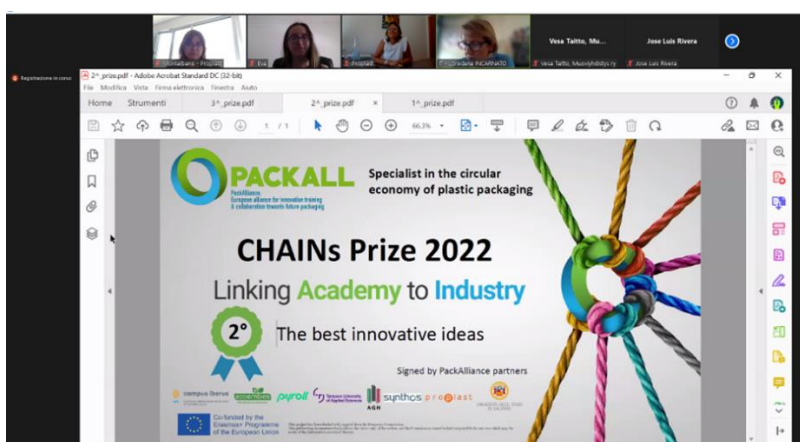


CHAINS Prize Event!!!

The PackAll CHAINS Prize on-line event has been on June 6th in Spain, Poland, Finland, and Italy.

More than 40 participants within students, mentors and partners have joining to the event of the CHAINS awards. The students, participated to the training course “SPECIALIST IN THE CIRCULAR ECONOMY OF PLASTIC PACKAGING”, have been completed the last module CHAINS. The event aimed to exhibit the ideas developed by the teams and awarded the first three prizes as “The best innovative ideas”.

During the CHAINS module, 2 teams of Italian students, 2 teams of Polish students, 1 team of Finnish students and 1 team of Spanish students supported and followed by academic and industrial mentors of each country, have found solutions for the challenges related to the CE and plastic packaging. The challenges to be solved were the substitution of traditional materials with biomaterials, consumer involvement in collection management and eco-design strategies to improve the management of complex packaging and reduction of single-use plastic boxes.



A team of 8 judges, within associated partner and project partners, have evaluated the ideas, the presentations and the videos prepared by the students.
